## **Morgan Sindall Construction & Infrastructure crowned Diversity & Inclusion Excellence winner**

In a prestigious ceremony, held at the Grosvenor Hotel in London, Morgan Sindall Construction & Infrastructure were thrilled to be announced as winners of the Construction News Awards 2019, Diversity & Inclusion Excellence category.

Representatives from the company's Construction and Infrastructure divisions both attended the event, which was a dual celebration as the Morgan Sindall Construction team in the Central region were also shortlisted in the Project of the Year £20 - £50 million category.

The shortlisted project, the Collaborative Teaching Laboratory, is a £40 million state-of-the-art STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) education facility delivered for the University of Birmingham in 2018.
